From Bowls Wellington AGM Agenda

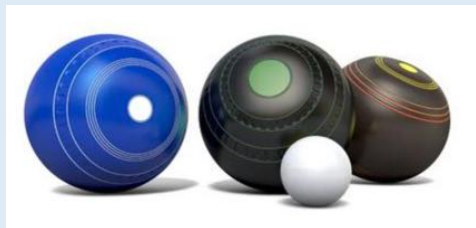


That a new Member definition be included called 'Limited Playing Member' in Rule 2.

'Limited Playing Member' means a person who

wishes to play bowls at their club only. The rights and privileges of membership as a Limited Playing Member shall be specified in the constitution, regulation and/or rules of the club, but cannot extend beyond specific club tournaments and events. A Limited playing member can only play in bowls events within the boundary of the physical club and may not participate in club championships, centre or national events, or at any events at another bowling club.

UMPIRES QUESTION



The last bowl of an end has just come to rest. One of the bowls in the head is lying at such an angle that it could fall over into a potential shot scoring position.

What time limit is allowed before the number of shots scored is decided?

Answer

30 seconds if either team ask for the 30 second period.

Note If after 30 seconds has elapsed and the bowl did not fall the opposition would be wise to wedge it
